I write in connection with your request for information received on 10th January. I note you seek access to the following information:

During the period 1st Jan 2015 until 31 December 2018

How many police officers or special constables or PCSO's have been jailed for offences committed whilst they were serving officers in the last 3 years.

Please provide details of the offence for which they were jailed.

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

Following enquiries within the Force please see our response below.

Response – During the period 1/1/2015-31/12/18 6 Bedfordshire officers were imprisoned. No PCSO's or specials were imprisoned. The offences were:

- Making indecent images / outraging public decency
- Misconduct in public office
- Fraud / Computer misuse
- Making indecent images
- Blackmail
- Criminal damage / act intending to pervert the course of justice
