How many recorded incidents, were sequentially recorded as the crime of rape and/or attempted rape, or any other sexual assault where the victim was an adult male in a same sex relationship

Please break down by type of offence eg 1 x rape 2 x sexual assault etc

Adult male is taken to mean a man over the age of 18 AT the time of the offence,

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.
