REQUEST UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 Ref No: FOI2019/00105

I write in connection with your request for information received on 4th January. I note you seek access to the following information:

I would like to know how many reports of:

- a) sexual harassment**
- b) sexual assault**
- c) rape**
- d) domestic abuse/violence**
- e) how many requests for restraining orders**

Of/from women aged 60 and over there have been in your force area - I AM SPECIFICALLY KEEN TO KNOW THESE STATISTICS IN RELATION TO THESE WOMEN'S PARTNERS.

I would like this information broken down by annual year for every year from 2013 to 2018. If it is possible, I would also like the ages of the women.

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

RESPONSE - Following enquiries within the Force please see our attached document marked **Annex A FOI2019 00105**.

Question a) - is not a recordable crime and we are unable to provide this information.

Question e) - this is not centrally recorded and therefore unable to provide this information.

Annex A FOI2019 00105 - sexual offences table contains information which shows the requested data without engaging Section 40 FOIA (Personal Information).

Please note - Bedfordshire Police made a significant investment in a new ICT system, Athena, in May of this year which, when fully implemented, will help keep Bedfordshire safe, bring more offenders to justice and improve outcomes for victims. Updating our ICT was absolutely necessary to ensure Bedfordshire Police remains as effective and efficient as possible. The public should be reassured crime continues to be reported and investigated as normal but whilst colleagues become more comfortable and familiar with how Athena works Bedfordshire Police has some concerns around data quality for which reason some of the data provided concerning events recorded after 23 May, may include some inaccuracies. We apologise for the situation and are working to resolve it as soon as possible.

The numerical data presented in this response is an un-audited snapshot of un-published data sourced from "live" systems and is subject to the interpretation of the original request by the individual extracting the data.
