I write in connection with your request for information received on 17th June. I note you seek access to the following information:

please provide the number of fines issued by the fixed speed cameras in Turvey in each of 2017, 2018 and 2019 to date.

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

RESPONSE - Following enquiries conducted by Bedfordshire Police and their Cameras, Tickets & Collisions Unit within the Force please see our response below: -

2017 – 24 Notices of Intended Prosecution
2018 – 82 Notices of Intended Prosecution
2019 (up until 31st May) - 0 Notices of Intended Prosecution

Notices of Intended Prosecution issued from cameras in Bedfordshire may not all be resolved by way of a fine, some offences will result in a speed awareness course and some may result in court action.

Bedfordshire Police do not hold prosecution information and fines are not paid to the Police. These are paid to the Fixed Penalty Office (Her Majesty's Courts and Tribunals Service) and paid onto central government.

The numerical data presented in this response is an un-audited snapshot of un-published data sourced from "live" systems and is subject to the interpretation of the original request by the individual extracting the data.
