3: Bedfordshire Police have no record of any Traffic Offence Reports (issued by officers at the roadside) or Notices of Intended Prosecution (issued from camera detected offences) for speed on Mill Road, Stanbridge. The SpeedWatch group have issued warning letters on 8 separate occasions since January 2019. The number of times speed checks have been completed at the location is not known.
