I write in connection with your request for information received on 30th August. I note you seek access to the following information:

**Speed camera in Westoning heading towards village centre
Please can you supply monthly breakdown for the last 12 months of drivers flashed by this camera**

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

RESPONSE - Following enquiries conducted by Bedfordshire Police and their Cameras, Tickets & Collisions Unit within the Force and they have been able to provide the number of times the camera has 'flashed' please see our response below: -

By the term "flashed by", Bedfordshire Police are of the understanding that this refers to the number of times the camera has been activated and not the number of Notices of Intended Prosecutions issued (NIP's).

Please note: Not all of the activations will have been valid offences as they include multiple test shots per film; emergency vehicles on response; false activations; double images from wet and digital cameras which provide two activations per offence etc.

For your information there have been 2986 Notices of Intended Prosecutions (NIP's) issued in the same timeframe.

The numerical data presented in this response is an un-audited snapshot of un-published data sourced from "live" systems and is subject to the interpretation of the original request by the individual extracting the data.
