I write in connection with your request for information received on 20th December. I note you seek access to the following information:

Hate-crime behaviour in the last 10 years across the UK.

- 1. The total number of reported hate-crimes in your Constabulary each year from January 1st 2009 to November 31st 2019.**
- 2. From those cases above, how many resulted in a conviction?**
- 3. Out of these hate-crimes, do you have statistics on how many were incidents of racism? If so, can this figure be included for each month?**
