I write in connection with your request for information received on 23rd December. I note you seek access to the following information:

Please can you provide details on the income / payments received by the force for participation in the Garden Productions Ltd's production "24 Hours in Police Custody" that airs on Channel 4.

I have already reviewed the force's annual reports and accounts and could find no details on this.

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

Following your request, searches were conducted at Bedfordshire Police for information relating to "income / payments received by the force for participation in the Garden Productions Ltd's production "24 Hours in Police Custody" that airs on Channel 4".
