I write in connection with your request for information received on 28th January. I note you seek access to the following information:

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), I would like to find out the following:

- **The total number of offences recorded in the police force area by a speed camera or from an officer's speed radar where a motorist was found to be going at or over 100mph, backdated for three years - 2017, 2018 and 2019**
- **If possible, for each offence recorded I would like to know the location of the offence, what the speed limit on the road was, the driver's age, the make and model of the vehicle and the gender of the driver**
- **The top five speeds recorded in the police force area, including what the speed limit was, the location of the offence, the driver's age, the make and model of the vehicle, and gender**

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.
