I write in connection with your request for information received on 20th April. I note you seek access to the following information:

**Between the dates of 23rd March 2020 and 13th April 2020 please provide the following information:**

- **The highest recorded speed by a driver within the force area that you police?**
- **What was the speed limit of the section of road where this speed was detected?**
- **On what stretch of road and at what time of day was this speed recorded?**
- **How many drivers were caught exceeding a 30mph limit in your force?**
- **How many drivers were caught exceeding a 20mph limit in your force?**
- **How many drivers were issued with a penalty for doing non-essential journeys in contravention of the Government's lockdown instructions?**
