**All reported crimes carried out on Greenacres , Slapton road, little Billington , lu79bp or by residents living at said site for period of 1st June 2010 to 1st June 2020**

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

**RESPONSE** - Following enquiries conducted by Bedfordshire Police and their crime recording systems within the Force please see our response in the tables below: -

We have searched for the beat code rather than the address as 'The Stables' is coming out as Stanbridge Road or Gypsy lane not Slapton Road and 'Greenacres' is Slapton Road or Gypsy Lane, also these are recorded crimes.
