I write in connection with your request for information received on 1st July. I note you seek access to the following information:

**Disability hate crime FOI request**

- 1. How many disability hate crimes have been recorded by your police force for the last two financial years – 2018/19 and 2019/20?**
- 2. How many disability hate crimes during each financial year (2018/19 and 2019/20) concerned acts of violence against a person?**
- 3. How many incidents of disability hate crime were recorded as taking place online in each financial year (2018/19 and 2019/20)?**
- 4. How many of the recorded disability hate crimes in each financial year (2018/19 and 2019/20) resulted in a charging decision?**
- 5. How many of the recorded disability hate crimes in each financial year (2018/19 and 2019/20) were prosecuted?**
- 6. How many of the recorded disability online hate crimes in each financial year (2018/19 and 2019/20) resulted in a charging decision?**
- 7. How many of the recorded disability online hate crimes in each financial year (2018/19 and 2019/20) were prosecuted?**

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.
