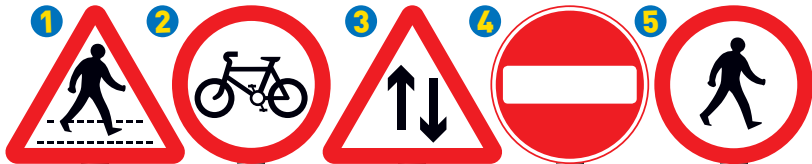

EYE EYE!

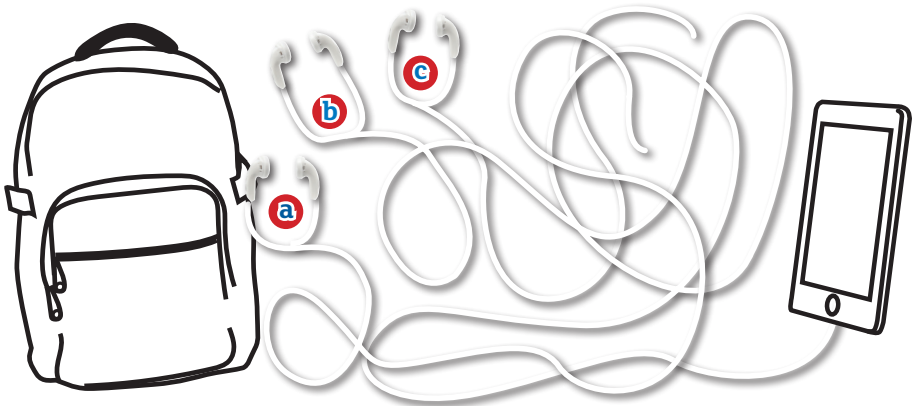


When you're crossing a road by bike or on foot – look right at drivers and try to “catch” their eye. If they make eye contact, you know they've seen you.
